- Candidates should report at the centre of the examination well in advance of the reporting time indicated on the e-Call Letter to complete activities such as verification of the candidate, capture of biometric(LTI) and photo, collection of documents, announcement of instructions and logging in etc.
- Candidates to note the following timings. The duration of CBT will be 90 minutes for 100 questions (120 minutes for PwBD candidates taking the CBT with scribe).

- No candidate will be allowed inside the test centre after gate closing time for the date and shift indicated in the e-Call Letter.
- Candidates are advised to locate their test centre and its accessibility at least a day before the test so that they can reach the centre on time on the day of the test.
- The e-Call Letter is to be submitted for verification at the time of the test. At least one **original and valid photo identification card** (i.e. not photocopied or scanned or expired) such as Voter Card, Aadhaar Card, printout of e-Aadhaar, Driving License, PAN card, Passport, Identity Card issued by the employer in case the candidate is a Govt. Employee, School / College / University Photo ID card, SSLC/HSC mark sheet with photo must be presented failing which he/she will not be permitted in the exam. **Photocopy of the ID proof will not be allowed.**
- This e-Call Letter is valid only for the test date, shift and time as specified thereon.
- Banned items/electronic gadgets such as Mobile phones, pager, watches, Bluetooth enabled devices, calculators, metallic wears, bangles, belts, bracelets etc. are **NOT ALLOWED** inside the Test Centre.
